### **Instructions and Rules**

#### **GLSF Academic Scholarship Application**

- 1. Grieg Lodge Scholarship Fund ("GLSF") was founded, in part, to "develop the pursuit of the intellect and education in all areas of life by providing scholarship grants, to encourage studies of the cultures of Norway and the United States, and for the advancement of literary, musical, artistic and historical creativity."
- 2. GLSF gives a minimum of three Academic scholarships of \$1,500 each year. In 2016 we gave 13 scholarships of \$2,000 each; in 2017 we gave 15 scholarships of \$2,000 each.
- 3. The Academic Scholarship Application consists of:
  - a. The Information Form;
  - b. An essay written by the applicant (see instruction page);
  - c. An official transcript from applicant's present school;
  - d. Each reference listed on applicant's Information Form must:
    - i. complete an official Recommendation Form; and
    - ii. provide a letter of recommendation.
- 4. All application materials must be postmarked no later than Thursday, February 15, 2018.
- 5. All application materials should be mailed to:

- 6. No certified mail can be accepted.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be included in the selection process.
- 8. Additional materials such as photographs and resumes will not be considered.
- 9. There is no age limit for applicants.
- 10. Eligibility is limited to students whose home address is in Multnomah, Clackamas, Columbia, Washington, and Yamhill Counties in Oregon, or Clark County, Washington.
- 11. Applicants do not need to have any affiliation with Grieg Lodge. However, preference will be given to applicants with a connection to Scandinavian heritage, culture and/or actiivies.
- 12. Previous scholarship recipients are eligible to apply for a 2018 scholarship. However, preference will be given to new applicants and new applications from those who have not previously received a GLSF scholarship.
- 13. Students chosen to receive an Academic Scholarship will be notified by March 31, 2018. Scholarships will be awarded at a Brunch on Sunday April 8, 2018.
- 14. The decision of the Grieg Lodge Scholarship Fund Board of Directors is final.
- 15. Scholarship awards will be made to the designated institution on behalf of the applicant after we receive proof of enrollment.
