

GLSF Fedde Grant Application

Instructions and Rules

Grieg Lodge Scholarship Fund (“GLSF”) was founded, in part, to “develop the pursuit of the intellect and education in all areas of life by providing scholarship grants, to encourage studies of the cultures of Norway and the United States, and for the advancement of literary, musical, artistic and historical creativity.”

The Bernhard & Johanna Fedde Grant is awarded annually in the amount of \$500. The Grant may be awarded to an individual or group working on a project or event that will benefit and enrich the public in a cultural manner.

The Fedde Grant Application consists of:

1. Fedde Grant Application Information Form.

2. Project Description: In 200-400 words:

- Describe the project or event for which the Grant is being requested.
- Include as much applicable detail as possible, including project or event name, date, location, and purpose.
- Tell how this project will advance literary, musical, artistic, or historical creativity, as well as benefit and enrich the public in a cultural manner.
- Itemize projected expenses.

This information should be typed, double-spaced, and checked for grammar and spelling.

The entire application must be postmarked no later than: **Thursday, February 1, 2024**. All application materials should be mailed to:

Incomplete or late applications will not be included in the selection process.

There is no age limit for applicants.

Eligibility is limited to individuals or groups based in Multnomah, Clackamas, Columbia, Washington, and Yamhill Counties in Oregon, or Clark County in Washington.

Need not be affiliated with Grieg Lodge. Preference will be given to applicants with a connection to Nordic (Danish, Finnish, Icelandic, Norwegian, Swedish) heritage, culture and/or activities.

Previous winners are eligible to apply for a 2024 GLSF Fedde Grant. However, preference may be given to new applicants and new applications from those who have not previously received a GLSF Fedde Grant.

Winners will be notified by **March 31, 2024**. Winners should plan to attend the Scholarship Award Ceremony at the Grieg Lodge Birthday Brunch, **Sunday, April 14, 2024**.

The decision of the Selection Committee, on behalf of the Grieg Lodge Scholarship Fund Board of Directors, is final.
